Required Training Equipment (to be brought to class each week):

- 6 ft. leather, nylon, or other soft style leash (no retractable or chain leashes)
- Flat buckle collar (snug enough to not slip off but not too tight) or head collar (Gentle Leader or Halti)
- Small pea sized training treats

Recommendations:

- Crazy Dog Train Me Treats
- Bil Jac treats cut into smaller pieces
- Charlie Bear treats (Can be easier on sensitive stomachs)
- Natural Balance food rolls cut into small pieces (Can be easier on sensitive stomachs)

Optional:

- Treat Bag
- Clicker (Required for those who attend clicker training workshop)

Important Safety Guidelines:

- Please wear comfortable clothing and flat soft soled shoes with backs (no flip flops or sandals)
- Keep your dog on leash and under control at all times unless otherwise told by instructor.

Vaccinations:

Puppies must be up-to-date on all required vaccinations, and proof of vaccinations must be presented upon enrollment, at the first class or faxed to 952-922-8147.

Helpful Hints:

- It is always good to give your dog a chance to eliminate before you arrive to class. He will learn better when he is not concerned about the need to eliminate.
- Bring a hungry dog to class. Do not feed a full meal before class, it is best to wait until after class or feed the meal three or more hours before class. A hungry dog will be more motivated to work for your treats.
- Give your dog plenty of exercise before coming to class. Some dogs will be too excited to learn if they do not receive exercise before class.
- Practice, practice, practice. First of all, stay positive and have fun! Use short 5-10 minute training sessions throughout the day to work with your dog. This keeps training fun and keeps their attention. The more you put into training, the more you will get out of it.
